Protecting Your Green Space

Fencing has been added to your green spaces to limit quad-bike access.



- Damage caused to your green space is unacceptable – spoiling your open areas and wasting your money to fix the damage.
- We'll continue to work with the police and community to identify the irresponsibly owners.
- We'll support enforcement action against those damaging public space and the environment.

Bulk Waste Fee Changes

We successfully lobbied to have fees removed for households on benefits.



- We'll continue to lobby for bulk charges to be fully removed once the Council can afford it.
- Fees were only introduced to fund and protect services due to Tory budget cuts.
- We'll support the community to combat those who break the law and spoil your environment.

Combating Dog Fouling

Efforts to educate dog owners will save tax money and protect public health.



- A public awareness campaign was launched to educate owners about the importance of cleaning up dog mess in our communities.
- It poses severe health risks to the young and vulnerable.
- Irresponsible owners not tidying up their dog's waste costs a large sum of your money to have removed.
- This means less money for other services.

Tackling Anti-Social Behaviour in Your Parks



- CCTV cameras have been installed to prevent crime and anti-social issues around Cross Flatts Park and its access points.
- Anti-social behaviour is unacceptable and we'll work with you, the police and the community to stop it where we can.

Protecting Your Public Spaces



- Illegal Traveller camps have caused damage to your public land - wasting your tax money.
- We'll work with you and the Traveller communities to find ways to make these happen less often.
- These camps damage the good name of the majority of Travellers who follow the rules.

Cleaning Your Community's Air



- Pollution from vehicles is damaging the health and well-being of people across the ward.
- This is contributing to premature deaths.
- We support the introduction of a Clean Air Zone, forcing the clean-up of your public transport system, and the expansion of Park and Ride across Leeds.

Hilary Championing Your Needs In Westminster



- Keeping the Tories in check on Brexit.
- Speaking against the closure of the Holbeck Delivery Office in the Commons.
- Continuing to support people in Hunslet with a range of complaints from benefit issues to immigration, and more.

The Tories Failing You

- The Tory cuts have caused huge harm to Leeds. In 2010 for every £1 raised in Leeds, approximately £2 came from the government. **It's now near 10p.**
- 6234 three-day emergency food supplies were given to people in crisis last year by the Leeds South and East Foodbank. **Tory policy is hurting the poor the hardest.**
- The Universal Credit rollout starts soon and we're worried the time gap between payments will hurt the less well-off hard. **Hurting the vulnerable.**
- These changes **impact women and the disabled the most.**
